Art - Map it out

I can sort map images into groups, explaining their choices.

draw a map of their journey to school, including key landmarks and different types of mark-making.

I can follow instructions to make a piece of felt that holds together and resembles their map.

I can make choices about which details from their map to include in a stained glass.

I can sew a running stitch with regular-sized stitches and understand that both ends must be knotted.

I can prepare and cut fabric to make a pouch from a template.

I can use a running stitch to join the two pieces of fabric together.
