<i>dead</i>	Something that was once alive but now is not.



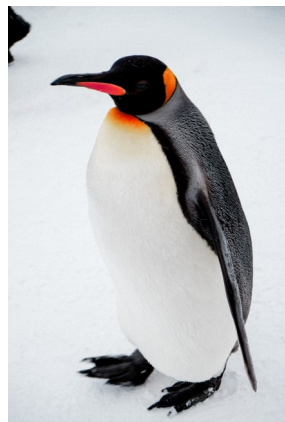
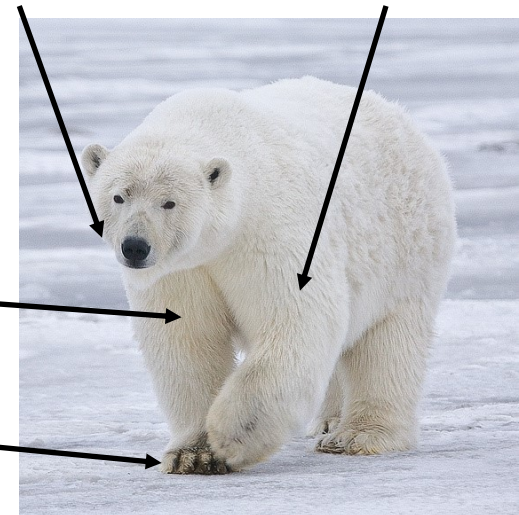
The polar habitats cover the North and South Poles. They are icy and typically cold and windy. The things that live there have to adapt to survive.
