### How it Works

The Essentials	Bonus Tasks
<p><b><u>Reading</u></b> Pick up your reading book and enjoy immersing yourself in a story. This could be you reading or being read to. Don't forget to write a comment in your reading records.</p> <p>Reading books will be changed Wednesday and Friday, so please bring in your reading books to change on these days.</p>	<p><b><u>Writing – Hieroglyphics</u></b> Create an Ancient Egyptians Rosetta stone and write a message in hieroglyphics.</p> <p>Make sure to provide a translation too!</p> <p><b><u>History – Pharaoh</u></b> Pharaohs were the god kings of ancient Egypt who ruled between 3150 B.C. and 30 B.C. Tutankhamun is one of the most famous of these pharaohs. Make a fact-file for him.</p> <p><b><u>D&amp;T – Amulets</u></b> Research Ancient Egyptian amulets. Use this information to either copy or design your own amulet in an Ancient Egyptian style. You could draw the amulet, or use other materials such as clay.</p>
<p><b><u>Spellings</u></b> You will be giving weekly spellings to practice and accompanying sheets. These are in accordance to the national curriculum. Each child will be given weekly spellings on Friday and will be tested on the following Friday.</p> <p>To help practise, you could try writing the words in fancy letters, bubble writing or different colours. You could even try to make the words using different materials.</p> <p>Don't forget to write your words into sentences.</p>	<p><b><u>Science – Sound</u></b> Experiment with how many different ways you can make sound. You could make improvised instruments and draw diagrams showing how they produce sound.</p> <p><b><u>Well-being – Family time - music</u></b> Spend time as a family listening to each other's favourite music. How is it the same? How is it different?</p>
<p><b><u>Times Tables Rock Stars</u></b> Times Tables are very important in Year 4, so we will be competing in a Year Group competition to see which class can win the most points. Keep practicing to earn points for your class.</p> <p>Speak to your teacher if you have forgotten your login.</p>	<p><b><u>Outdoor –</u></b> Create a soundscape when going for a walk outside with your family. Be imaginative and find a way to record what you can see and hear.</p> <p><b><u>Zones of Regulation</u></b> Spend time listening to music, and consider which Zone it makes you feel. You could record this in a drawing or on a map.</p>
