Ideas could include: finding out about a well-known person or people; products grown or exported; a particular country; one particular continent or landmarks. These are just examples. Anything else you can think of (linked to the Americas) would be great too. This could be you reading or being read to and can be fiction or non-fiction books. Don't Forget to talk about your book with an adult. What are the main characters like? How are they feeling?
