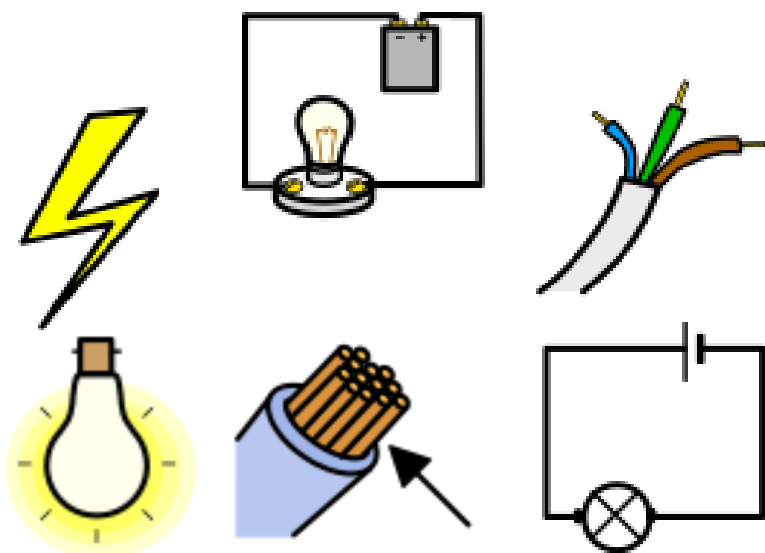


Year 4 Term 5 – Electricity

<i>electricity</i>	<i>The flow of an electric current through a material, e.g. from a power source through wires to an appliance.</i>
<i>appliances</i>	
<i>battery</i>	<i>A device that stores electrical energy as a chemical. Two or more cells joined together form a battery.</i>
<i>circuit</i>	
<i>mains electricity</i>	<i>Electricity supplied through wires to a building.</i>
<i>electrical conductor</i>	
<i>electrical insulator</i>
