<p><u>Writing – Evacuation Leaflet</u> Write a leaflet which would be given to children who were being evacuated during WW2. You will need to think about what they would need to take and what they would need to prepare.</p>	4	<p><u>Reading</u> Curl up and read a good book. Write a review of the best book you have read this year. Talk to someone at home about what you have read.</p>	2
<p><u>Topic – Topic – Battle of Britain</u> Research the Battle of Britain. You may choose to display your findings as you wish – poster, leaflet, artistically, video etc.</p>	4	<p><u>Spellings</u> Practise your spelling words in the way which you find most useful. <p><u>D&T – Anderson Shelter</u> Create a model of an Anderson Shelter using a range of materials.
