

Home Learning Menu Year 5 Term 6: How has migration shaped Britain?



How it Works

Homework is a great addition to your child's learning and an opportunity to consolidate and stretch their minds.

Weekly tasks have a positive impact across all lessons and so **should** be completed multiple times a week. **Bonus** tasks are optional, termly and can be completed to stretch and consolidate your child's knowledge of our varied curriculum.

Occasionally your child may come home with **targeted** homework to help in a particular area. As well as enhancing your child's learning homework is a great opportunity to earn **extra dojo points**; all you have to do is record it in their homework book. Your child's weekly spelling results will also be communicated back to you using this book.

Weekly Tasks

Reading	Keep a record of every time you read with someone. When you finish a book you can complete a book review or your choice of Genre Badge challenge. Challenge: Can you find a word that your teacher doesn't know the meaning of?
Spelling Practice	Use Spelling Frame or your homework book to practise the rules you have learned for your weekly spelling test.
Maths Practice	Use Mathletics to recap learning in school. You should also use Times Tables Rock Stars or have a family member test your recall of the multiplication tables. This will help you improve in your maths lessons.
Life Skills	This is an opportunity for you to share what you have done outside of school (ie. Karate, Scouts, Dance class, cooking or baking). Just jot a little about it in your homework book; we love to read about all the amazing things you do outside of school!

Bonus Tasks

History – How has migration shaped Britain?	Imagine you are a child travelling from the Caribbean to England on the Windrush ship. Write a postcard to your family / friends back home. What can you see on the journey? How are you feeling? What do you hope England will be like?
Music - Exploring the associations between music, sounds and colour	Choose a song you like. Create a graphic score (sequence of symbols and drawings) to represent what the song means to you, and what it makes you think of.

PE	Play your own game of rounders or cricket with friends. Practise batting and fielding skills – how far can you throw a ball? Can you hit the ball on the first swing?
