## The Home Learning Menu

These tasks are optional week on week. However, completing the tasks in the column on the right will be beneficial to your child's learning and progress. If your family have to isolate, resulting in time off school, please complete the tasks on the Home Learning Menu.

### Side Orders (Optional)

These activities, which link with the topics being studied in class, can be completed to further extend your child's learning.

- Create a poster about the royal family.
- Identify and create your own family tree.
- Identify and use recycled materials to make a model of a car, plane or rocket.
- Go on a hunt around your home for items you can squash, twist, bend and stretch.
- Bake a cookie and decorate it with something that reminds you of Britain.
- Bake cookies in the shapes of Christmas objects. What unit of measurement do you use?
- Collage (using different materials) the British flag.
- Create your own shoebox nativity scene. What are the key parts of the Christian Christmas Story?

### Main Courses (Compulsory)

A range of these activities must be completed **most days** in order to support your child's learning.

#### Reading

- Read the school reading book and talk about the story.  
What are the main characters like? How are they feeling? What might happen next?
- Share a story with your child.

#### Spellings

- Practise the weekly spelling words and high frequency words (Blue Year 1 and Year 2 Exception Words sheet). You could play a spelling game (chalking on your patio, writing in multi colours or make them out of playdough).
- Practise using the words in sentences.

#### Mathletics

Work is sometimes set, but you have access to all the activities and to score lots of points regularly visit Live Mathletics which helps build fluency.
