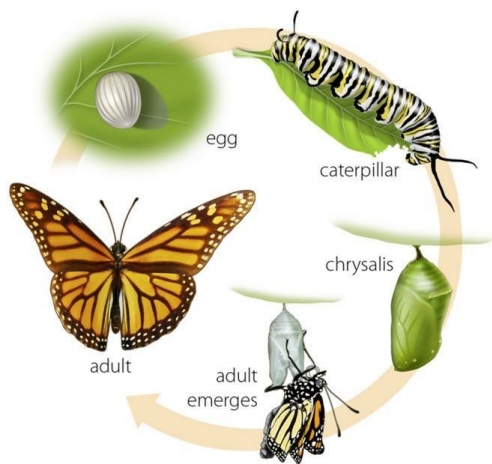
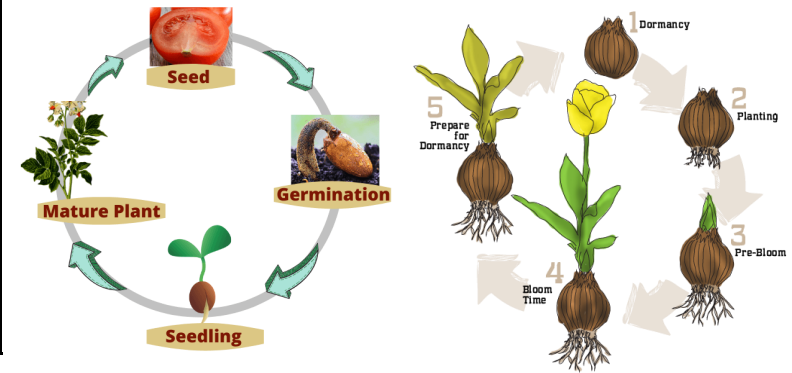


# Plants Term 4

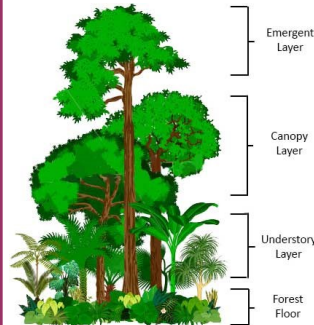
## Key Vocabulary

<i>requirements for life</i>	Things plants need to grow and survive.
<i>temperature</i>	How hot or cold it is.
<i>germination</i>	When a seed begins to sprout.
<i>life cycle</i>	The process by which a living thing grows from a baby or seed into an adult.

The Amazon Rainforest is home to as many as 80,000 plant species. The Venus Fly Trap can even catch and eat bugs!



Can you follow the life cycle of the butterflies we have in class?



Plants need water, nutrients, the correct temperature and sunlight in order to grow. Plants in the Amazon Rainforest have adapted to the climate there. Plants growing on the rainforest floor need

less sunlight to grow and can stretch their leaves to reach any sunlight nearby. They are also adapted to catch rain water dripping from the plants higher up.
